As part of the curriculum, we will be taking the children to the Safety Centre at Kiln Farm, Milton Keynes, for a half day session as follows:

MONDAY:	7 NOVEMBER	PM SESSION	6AA/ HALF OF 6AB
WEDNESDAY:	9 NOVEMBER	AM SESSION	6JC/ HALF OF 6AB

The children will be transported there by coach.

The Safety Centre contains several scenarios depicting hazards found both in and out of doors. We feel it is essential that the children attend as they will be given unique opportunities to experience realistic emergency crisis situations in a safe environment. The children and teachers are conducted in small groups by trained organisers. They will find the visit both informative and exciting. It will further build on experiences in Year 6 and prepare them for Secondary School. It has been requested by the Centre that all children wear trousers, as part of their school uniform.

The visit will be free on this occasion; this is due to a one-off special deal via the LA.
