**Children return on Wednesday 7 September 2011.**

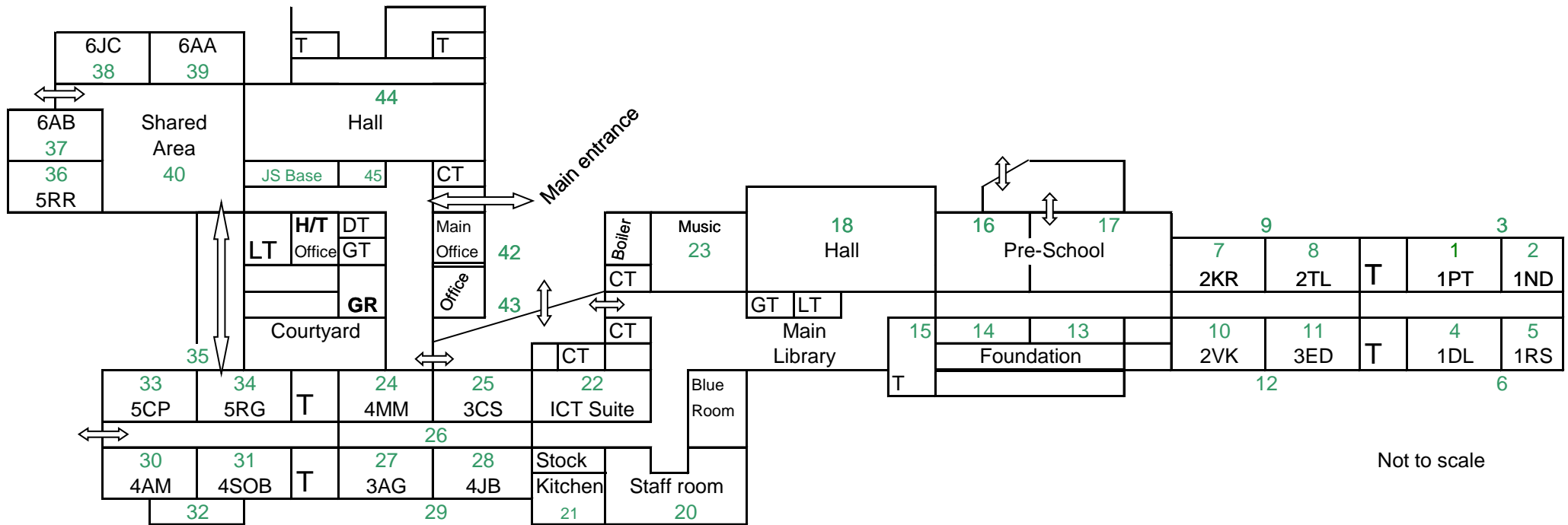
